No dogs are to be allowed to be "off lead" - due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, dogs shalt be "on lead" at all times on any area of the tracking site.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entries. The Tracking Tests are for dogs not less than six months old. Dogs who have NOT passed a 'Tracking Test' must file with the entry, an original Certification Statement, dated within 12 months and signed by a person who is accredited by the AKC to judge a 'Tracking Test', that the dog is considered by the judge to be ready for such a test. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog. Owners are responsible for errors in making out the entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded, in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date other than those provision outlined below.

Draw for Entries will be at the home of the Test Secretary, 4520 Winchester Rd, Petersburg, PA 16669, at 7:00 pm. Eastern Time on October 9, 2019. The drawing shall be completely at random among all entries received, except that *preference* shall be **given** to Weimaraner dogs which have not previously *earned* a Tracking title. If the limit is not reached in Weimaraners, other breeds may enter using the following procedure: Draw (1) Weimaraner without a title; Draw (2) Weimaraners with a title; Draw (3) Other breeds without a title; Draw (4) Other breeds with a title. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be assigned a position on the alternate lists corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2 The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed.
