Directions from the NORTH (Charlottesville)

- Exit 20 South from I-64
- Thru Scottsville, VA
- Cross Slate River Bridge
- Turn Right on 649, or Slate River Mill Rd.
- Pass 658, Saint Andrews Church Rd.
- Go thru wooded area. When at wooden fence on left look for entrance gate on left. There will be dog signs at gate.

Directions from I-64 at Zion Crossroads and Rt. 15

- South on 15 thru Fork Union and cross James River Bridge
- Go thru Dillwyn to Rt 60 at Sprouses' Corner
- Follow Rt 60 west thru Buckingham Courthouse (35 mph)
- Road narrows with STOP SIGN at fork
- Go right on 649 or Slate River Mill Rd
- Go half mile to gate on right. There will be dog signs at gate.
