2020 WCA Mid-America Field Classic

Grounds: Camp Robinson SUA is 4,029 total acres. The area is composed of grasslands, oak savanna, an upland oak and hickory forest as well as bottomland hardwood forests. Approximately 3,000 acres are in the field trial area, with 1,200 to 1,300 acres in grasslands with mowed strips and food plots. The area is managed for small game.

Horses: A current Coggins is required on all horses. No wrangler will be available at this trial. Six outdoor corral pens, and a 60 horse barn with inside and outside stalls are available.

Dogs: Outside kennels are available. Water is available on site for participants, horses and dogs.

Camping: Camping on the grounds is permitted. There are 12 designated electric hook-ups (30 amp) with water pedestals. It is possible to get two trailers on each site. There is no charge for camping. Due to electric and water lines running through the camping area, dog stakeouts are not allowed.

Club House: Due to COVID-19 only 25 people are allowed in the clubhouse at one time. The outside covered patio has picnic tables and has no restrictions on the number of people. Restrooms are available inside the clubhouse during the day, and outdoor bathrooms and showers will be open during the trial.

Food: Food will be available during the running of the trial. Lunch and dinner (no breakfast) will be prepared by Judy Tipton. Moderate charges will apply to meals. Exception will be the banquet which will be \$25 a plate.
