Courses and Birds

All stakes shall be run on a single course. Chukar and/or quail shall be released in all stakes except Open Puppy. Wild birds may also be on course. Chukar and/or quail will be used for retrieving – callbacks at judges' discretion. Grand Open Limited All Age, Open Gun Dog and Amateur Gun Dog are retrieving stakes. Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes.

A blank cartridge will not be fired in the Puppy stake.

Tracking collars will be permitted in all stakes as per AKC rules.

Prizes

Standard AKC rosettes to all placed dogs. Trophy to 1st place of the stake.
WCA Rotating Trophies to the first place dog in Grand Open Limited All Age, Field Futurity, and Amateur Gun Dog.

Futurity placements awarded according to WCA Field Futurity Rules.

DIRECTIONS to Jones Corral – Spenceville Wildlife area:

Coming from the South (CA 99 north):

Take CA 70 North to Olivehurst approx. 18 miles
Turn right on Erle Road
Turn left on Goldfields Parkway
Turn right on Beale Road
Turn left on Griffith Avenue
Turn right on Hammonton/Smartville Road
Travel approximately 13 miles and Turn right on Chuck Yeager Road
Turn left on Waldo Road which is an un-gated gravel road
Travel down Waldo Road as it goes over the old bridge.
Take a left at the Y in the road
The road will Y again and stay to the left
Jones Corral is on the right side about a ½ mile

If using GPS, you can enter Spenceville Firing range to get to Waldo Road and follow directions above from there.

IMPORTANT!!!! If you are traveling with a trailer or vehicle taller than 11.5 feet, take the route below instead. You will NOT be able to get across the old bridge using the directions above

Alternate route:

Take Interstate 80 to Hwy 65
Take Hwy 64 toward Wheatland
Once entering Wheatland, make a right onto Spenceville Road
Follow the road for a few miles and make a right onto Camp Far West Rd
At the Y, veer to the left. Do not take the bridge to the right
Camp Far West Rd goes for several miles and ends at Speceville Rd
Make a right and enter the Spenceville Wildlife Area

WATER: Please plan to supply your own water for yourself and your animals for the duration of your stay.

PARTICIPANTS: Are required to fill-in holes, spread horse manure, and clean up after their dogs. Dogs must be on leash, check cord, or staked out at all times unless under active judgement in the stake(s) which they are entered.

PRIMITIVE “DRY” CAMPING: Is permitted, Porta-Potty on-site

HORSES: Wrangler will be on site. **Reservations are required.** Please contact Terry Zygalski at (831) 818-5932 for reservations. Cost is \$135 for the day or \$75.00 for a half day.

WEATHER: Please be prepared for all types of weather. Bring layers and possible rain gear.

MEALS: Order ahead breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be available. See attached form and return with your entry.
