Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes except AWP

Walking handling is permitted for all stakes and walking handlers will be braced together when possible. **PLEASE INDICATE IF YOU WILL BE A WALKING HANDLER VIA EMAIL TO SECRETARY. (PERFDOG DOES NOT COLLECT THIS INFO)**

A blank cartridge will not be fired in puppy stakes.

Birds will not be planted for either puppy stakes. There may be birds present from previous stakes for OP. AWP runs on a separate course, pending course conditions, where no other stakes are run.

Tracking Collars are permitted.

Roading of dogs behind the gallery is prohibited.
